**PLEASE NOTE: NO PLASTIC BAGS SUPPLIED – MEAT WILL BE INJECTED ON SITE, PLEASE BRING A LEAK PROOF CONTAINER FOR YOUR BAITS.**

### How do I participate in the Program?

- **REGISTER** your interest with Council.  
Meat will be supplied by Council – maximum **50 baits** free of charge per property.
- If you would like to bring **EXTRA MEAT** to be injected, please ensure it is free of bone and skin and:
  - Wild Dog meat is minimum 125g in size
  - Feral Pig meat is minimum 500g in size
- Give all adjoining neighbours **3 DAYS NOTICE PRIOR TO BAITING**. This must now be recorded, so either by letter, email or text message.
- Bring your **RATES NOTICE** when collecting baits.
- Bring **SEALABLE, LEAK-PROOF** containers. The State Government no longer supplies plastic bags for 1080 baiting.
