## INGLEWOOD BOWLS CLUB

## FISHING



Fancy some freshwater fishing in a countryside environment? The Inglewood area including the Macintyre Brook (just a short stroll from the main street) and Lake Coolmunda are rated as one of the area's best 'sweet water' fishing spots with Golden Perch (Yellowbelly), Murray Cod, Silver Perch, Eel Tail Catfish (Jewfish), Boney Bream and Spangled Perch. If you need bait or fishing supplies, you can visit the local service station and the local hardware store Wilshire & Co sell fishing line and gear.

## BIRD-WATCHING AND BUSH WALKING



Inglewood is an area diverse in habitat and home to a rich array of birds, with over 200 species identified. There is an abundance of birdlife around Inglewood, with some great walking tracks around Lake Coolmunda. Alternatively you can explore the Olive Grove walk in town at the Apex/Lions Park which is a leisurely stroll, and a great place for a BBQ or picnic.

## INGLEWOOD HERITAGE CENTRE & AUSTRALIAN TOBACCO MUSEUM



Guests are always amazed at the comprehensive written and pictorial history of the Inglewood district when visiting this museum. Housed in the original Cobb & Co Building and showcasing 'The Squatter's Legacy'; 'The Golden Leaf' of the Tobacco industry; a 'Dam Good Idea'; and numerous historic relics there is plenty to explore. Combined with the recent addition of a scale replica tobacco barn, you will not be disappointed with what you will learn from this fantastic museum. Now open 7 days a week thanks to digital self check-ins and interactive guides.

## INGLEWOOD OLIVE WALKWAY

Following the town's Olive trees, the Inglewood Olive Walkway takes you on a historical journey with a series of interpretive signs detailing interesting happenings and events in the area, and a monument in memory of Alan Cunningham who crossed and named the MacIntyre Brook on 30 May 1827.

The walkway is split into two sections, with a short walk of 1.3-kilometres or enjoy the full 2.2-kilometre circuit.

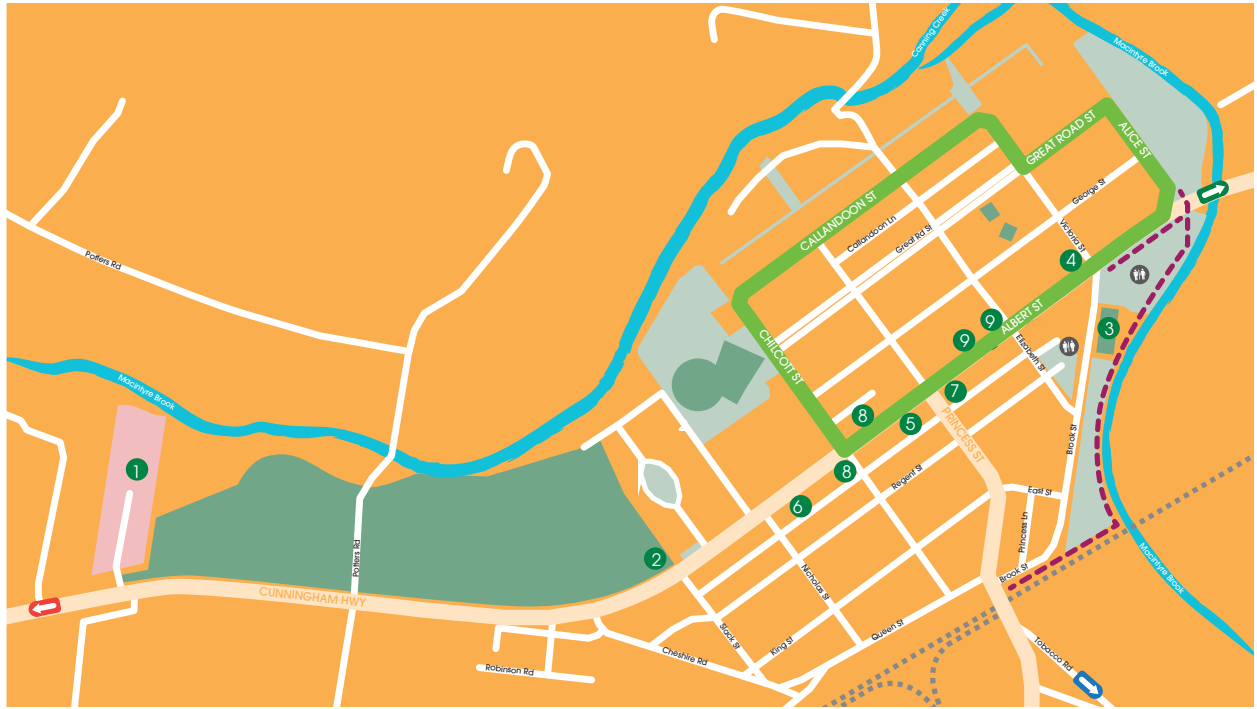
