Smoke from Greenup State Forest, Greenup/Limevale area

The Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) will be conducting a planned burn on Greenup State Forest between 1 May and 2 May 2018, weather permitting.

This burn is part of the annual hazard reduction program conducted by QPWS. As a result of this burn, smoke may be seen southeast of Inglewood.

The aim of this burn is to reduce the build-up of forest fuels and mitigate the threat of high intensity fires on the reserve. The burn will also provide favourable conditions for natural forest regeneration.

Smoke will decrease visibility on the Greenup/ Limevale road so it is important that motorists drive safely to the conditions.
